Brain Gym

Brain Gym is a movement based learning program, which helps improve neurological function so that areas of the brain are more strongly connected.

The program encompasses 26 exercise movements, which enhance ability to learn and process information. Skills such as hand eye co-ordination; balance and body awareness; processing symbols and crossing the midline. These are necessary for concentration, relaxation, attention, communication, memory, reading and writing, just to name a few. There is a poster of these exercises up in the preschool room.





OOSH Update

Welcome back Kim after her amazing holiday, we have missed her and cannot wait to hear all of her wonderful stories.

Some children have been learning about galaxies at school. This has extended in to OOSH and after researching further, an activity of "Galaxy in a Bottle" was decided on. Children made a list of materials needed and the children started the process. Using cotton balls, glitter paint and glass jars, the creativity began with older children assisting younger children to complete the task. These were turned into necklaces for the children to wear their Galaxy or carry them with them.





Mobile Preschool Update

Children have been exploring their creative side, with the introduction of a self-help creativity table. Children have been creating books, presents, pictures, and other resources to use in their play. We are continue to add inspirational pieces to spark their imaginations; currently it is Easter themed pictures.

At Broke, we have been watching the watermelons grow in anticipation. We recently found some ladybugs on the leaves, which led to research on how ladybugs can help plants as they eat other bad insects.

At Mount Olive, children are engaged in cooking role-play in the sandpit. The children have been cooking some wonderful "foodtastic creations" for the group to enjoy.

At both venues, we have noticed an increasing amount of toys brought from home. Although it is wonderful that the children want to share a piece of their home lives with their peers, Please limit the items from home to be one comfort item.
