Installation of rainwater tanks must comply with SEPP Exempt and Complying Development Code Part 2 Division 1 Subdivision 32 and 33.

The rebate amount is published in Council's Operational Plan annually.</li> </ol> </li> <li>To be eligible for the rebate the applicant must have installed a rainwater tank that:         <ol> <li>Was purchased on or after 01 July 2012, evidence of purchase and installation is required;</li> <li>Has a minimum capacity of 2,000 litres;</li> <li>Is not installed as a requirement for new development or BASIX requirements:</li> <li>Is not installed as a requirement on a condition of development / construction or subdivision consent;</li> <li>Is in accordance with the current NSW Code of Practice Plumbing and Drainage;</li> <li>Is on land that has an approved connection to a potable water supply owned by Council;</li> <li>Is a new tank and is covered by a minimum of 12 months warranty;</li> <li>Has all associated plumbing work completed by a licensed plumber;</li> <li>Is used for collection and storage of rainwater for use on the site; and</li> <li>Is to operate for a period of five years after installation.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Council has inspected internal plumbing connection to toilet and/or washing machine under s68 of the Local Government Act 1993, NSW.</li> </ol>
