Odds and Evens explained – if you street number is odd you can water on odd numbered days, if it is even you can water on even numbered days. If the street number is a number range, the first number in the range determines odds or evens. Excerpt from table 5 of Singleton Council's Drought Management and Emergency Response Plan. WSAP refers to Water Saving Action Plan.
