PERMANENT WATER SAVING MEASURES

Common sense everyday actions to help save water and reduce water bills.



GARDEN AND LAWN

ANYTIME - Hand-held hose with trigger nozzle attached, watering can or bucket only.



USE OF SPRINKLERS AND IRRIGATION (INCLUDING NEW TURF)

4PM - 10AM - Fixed to a timer and not left unattended.



WASHING OF VEHICLES AND BOATS

ANYTIME - Hand held hose with trigger nozzle or a bucket.



WASHING DOWN OF HARD SURFACES (PATHS AND DRIVEWAYS)

BANNED - Use a broom or blower instead.



USING WATER TO COOL DOWN PEOPLE OR ANIMALS

ANYTIME



TOPPING UP SWIMMING POOLS

ANYTIME - Fixed to a timer and not left unattended.



ACCIDENTS, HEALTH HAZARDS, DEFEND AGAINST FIRE

ANYTIME - No restrictions in the event of threat to people, wildlife or property.

It is important to remember, even when water restrictions are not in place, water saving rules apply.
