Common sense everyday actions to help save water and reduce water bills.

- GARDEN AND LAWN

  ANYTIME Hand-held hose with trigger

  nozzle attached, watering can or bucket only.
- USE OF SPRINKLERS AND
  IRRIGATION (INCLUDING NEW TURF)
  4PM 10AM Fixed to a timer and not left unattended.
- WASHING OF VEHICLES AND BOATS

  ANYTIME Hand held hose with trigger nozzle or a bucket.
- WASHING DOWN OF HARD SURFACES
  (PATHS AND DRIVEWAYS)

  BANNED Use a broom or blower instead.
- USING WATER TO COOL DOWN PEOPLE OR ANIMALS ANYTIME
- TOPPING UP SWIMMING POOLS

  ANYTIME Fixed to a timer and not left unattended.
- ACCIDENTS, HEALTH HAZARDS, DEFEND AGAINST FIRE ANYTIME No restrictions in the event of threat to people, wildlife or property.

It is important to remember, even when water restrictions are not in place, water saving rules apply.
