

## UPDATE | FEBRUARY 2020

Singleton Town Centre - Stage 2 focuses on John Street from the Ryan Avenue intersection north to Campbell Street, and from Campbell Street to the New England Highway.

The \$7 million project is funded by Singleton Council and the RestartNSW Resources for Regions program.

50% designs were unveiled for community comment in November 2019, and a 75% design has now been received following feedback.

Construction is anticipated to commence in June 2020, following a tender process to engage a contractor to undertake the works.

The contract will include conditions that access to businesses will be available during business hours while construction is underway. Power outages will not be permitted during business hours.

A one-way traffic option for Hunter Street considered as an ancilliary to the project is awaiting feedback from the NSW Government and further consultation will occur independently of the Town Centre Upgrade.

Removal of redundant fuel tanks is currently being undertaken on the corner of John and Elizabeth streets to address residual risk associated with previous use fuel storage.

## KEY COMPONENTS OF THE STAGE 2 UPGRADE INCLUDE:

- New street lighting
- Undergrounding of power
- New landscaping and street furniture
- Assessment of several intersections and potential upgrades
- · Improvements in traffic safety
- Traffic and parking management
- Footpath improvement
- Improvements to pedestrian connectivity
- Enhancement of pedestrian access for all abilities
- Assessment of and potential improvements to the storm-water network
- Assessment of and potential improvement to road pavement
