

FROM 1 JULY 2018

Water wise rules apply from 1 July 2018 to everyone who uses water sourced from Singleton Council, including residents, businesses and the government.

The rules are simple common sense everyday actions to save drinking water and reduce water bills.

THREE KEY RULES

These rules are permanent water saving measures and there are three key changes to remember.

- Watering with a sprinkler, irrigation system or hose is permitted any day before 10am or after 4pm.
- All hand held hoses must have a trigger nozzle attached.
- No hosing of hard surfaces such as concrete, paths and driveways.







4PM TO 10AM



WATER YOUR LAWN





WATER YOUR GARDEN



These actions can be performed any day before 10am or after 4pm. This avoids the heat of the day when wastage occurs due to evaporation.

AT ANYTIME

These actions can be performed anytime. Remember, hoses must always be used with a trigger nozzle, whatever the action or time of day. You can use a broom or blower vac to sweep hard surfaces.

Singleton Council's Water supply can be used in the event of, or to prevent, an accident, health hazard, surface discolouration or environmental issue. You can always use water to defend property from fire or test fire protection systems. Watering systems can be used to establish new lawns and gardens for up to 14 days from installation. Other exemption may apply.
