Sushi Rice Balls

Ingredients	
Sushi rice, rinsed, drained	1 Cup
Frozen peas, corn and capsicum	1/2 Cup
Sliced ham, finely chopped	60g
Green onions, thinly sliced	2
Sushi seasoning	1/2 Cup
Salt reduced soy, to serve	

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Method

- 1. Cook rice following packet directions. Transfer to a large bowl.
- 2. Meanwhile, place frozen vegetables in a heatproof bowl. Cover with boiling water. Stand for 2 minutes. Drain. Refresh under cold water.
- Add vegetables, ham, onion and seasoning to rice. Stir until well combined. Spread over a large tray lined with baking paper. Set aside to cool.
- 4. Using damp hands, roll level tablespoons of rice mixture into balls. Place on a tray lined with baking paper. Serve with soy sauce.
